

The Ballarat Remembrance Day service will be held at the Arch of Victory at 10.15am on Sunday, 11 November. The City of Ballarat, the Arch of Victory/Avenue of Honour Committee, both the Ballarat and Sebastopol RSL and Legacy are working together to create a respectful event with a connection to the local community, to commemorate 100 years since the end of World War 1.

Please allow 10 minutes to park in Victoria Park and walk up to the Arch.

The Buninyong RSL will also host a Remembrance Day commemorative service. Assembly at 10.30am with the service to commence at 10.45am in the Buninyong RSL Memorial Park.

The following road closures will be implemented:

- Sturt Street in both directions will be closed from Insignia Boulevard through to Vale Street
  - Learmonth Road will be closed at Cuthberts Road
- (Access from Insignia Boulevard onto Sturt Street to travel west, as well as access from Vale Street onto Sturt Street to travel east, will be maintained during the closure)

All east and west-bound traffic moving through the closure area will be diverted via Arthur Street and Cuthberts Road. Alternatively, traffic could also use Ring Road. Full access to the Ballarat Golf Course will be maintained during the closure period.

For those wanting to access the Ballarat CBD, please use the Midland Highway or Ring Road/Howitt Street where possible.

For all other road closures, please adhere to the detour signs or follow instruction from Traffic Management staff.
